HHS DISMISSES ACIP MEMBERS

HHS Sets Reconstitution of Advisory Committee for Immunization Practices (ACIP) in Motion

On Monday, June 9, the U.S. Department of Health and Human Services (HHS) announced the dismissal of all members of the Advisory Committee for Immunization Practices (ACIP). Secretary Kennedy is quoted in the HHS news release as saying, "A clean sweep is necessary to reestablish public confidence in vaccine science. ACIP's new members will prioritize public health and evidence-based medicine. The Committee will no longer function as a rubber stamp for industry profit-taking agendas."

Healthcare and medical organizations quickly released statements expressing deep concern at the abrupt actions taken by HHS Secretary Kennedy. AMA President, Bruce Scott, MD, was quoted saying, "For generations, ACIP has been a trusted national source of science and data-driven advice and guidance on the use of vaccines to prevent and control disease. Physicians, parents, community leaders and public health officials rely on them for clinical guidance, public health information, and knowledge. The removal of the 17 sitting members of ACIP undermines that trust and upends a transparent process that has saved countless lives".

BCBS LAWSUIT & SETTLEMENT

Claim Submission Due July 29, 2025

The November 2024 Blue Cross Blue Shield (BCBS) lawsuit impacting physicians resulted in a \$2.8 billion antitrust settlement. The lawsuit, initiated in 2012, alleged that BCBS colluded to limit competition and lower reimbursement.

Physicians who provided healthcare services and submitted claims to BCBS between July 24, 2008, and October 4, 2024, are eligible to submit claims for a share of the settlement. Approximately \$160 million of the full settlement was specifically allocated for professional providers.

The settlement aims to address antitrust violations and promote fair competition within the healthcare industry. It is expected to bring changes to how BCBS operates, potentially leading to more competitive pricing and improved services for providers and patients.

AMA HOUSE OF DELEGATES 2025

WY Physician Delegates Represent at AMA HOD

Wyoming physicians, Stephen Brown, MD (AMA Delegate), and David B. Wheeler, MD, PhD, (AMA Alternate Delegate), carried Wyoming's physician voice to the floor of the American Medical Association (AMA) House of Delegates (HOD) this past weekend in Chicago.

The 2025 House of Delegates meeting focused on strengthening medical education, addressing prior authorization at the federal level, and adopting new public health policies. Key highlights included efforts to ease Step 1 stress as well as great debates about a number of public health policies, including the

alcohol product labeling, ultraprocessed foods, and the need for continued education around the importance of physician-led care.

The AMA's advocacy efforts around protecting Medicare and Medicaid drew some contention with division amongst the delegates about the AMA strategy and extent to which the AMA voice should be elevated in this important policy work. Read more highlights from the meeting HERE.
