

Learn from peers how simple pre-exposure prophylaxis (PrEP) for HIV can be and how your role may be key to addressing health inequities and preventing PrEP deserts. This session explores local data on unmet PrEP needs, examines the structural barriers impacting uptake, and offers practical guidance on initiating PrEP, including an overview of current regimens, CDC recommendations, and key implementation considerations. Participants will also be introduced to HealthHIV's flagship certification programs that support physicians in building confidence and capacity to expand PrEP access.
